WHAT IT TAKES

1 // SOME SPACE

Nothing fancy. Just a space/stage about 20'X 20' without anything in the way (chairs, plants, small children).

2 // SOME TECH

- A sound system
- 35 mm (headphone jack) AUX input or CD player
- Mixing board
- A couple of microphones for the talk-back

3 // SOME PROMO

Delegate a postering crew (Find poster attached) and plaster posters around town! Advertise in your local press! Contact Local radio!

4 // AND... SOMEWHERE TO CRASH

We ask that every community finds billets for our company members. This way we can get to know you folks and keep costs low.
